Directions

40 minutes from Dublin Airport via M1. Follow the M1 to Louth. Take exit 10 from M1. Follow N51 to Slane Village. Turn right onto N2 in Slane village heading for Dublin. The Millhouse is on the right at the bottom of the hill before crossing the bridge over the River Boyne. Travelling on the M50 take the M2 then N2 to Slane. The Millhouse is on the left as you cross over the Bridge. Travelling from the North, take M1 to Collon exit 12 and join the N2. As you arrive to the green gates, please press the buzzer and one of our team will open the gate. Drive through the main gates and down the avenue and the carpark is located behind The Millhouse.

Carparking

For guests staying in The Millhouse please use the first half of the carpark. Bring your bags and make your way to Reception through the front door of the Main House.

Check In

Upon check in at The Millhouse, our receptionist will run through your booked programme and direct you on the location of your bedroom, the outdoor cold plunge and sauna and where your meals will be served. Please ensure if you have any last minute changes or requests to notify our staff member at this point if not already notified and included on your programme.

What to pack

All towels and toiletries are provided. Please ensure you bring a swimming suit, towel / bathrobe & flip flops for using the outdoor hot tub & sauna. Footwear: please pack a pair of wellies or good walking boots if you plan to follow any of the walking trails in the area or if you intend to go for a walk along the river or in the Mill Wood.

Outdoor Cold Plunge & Sauna

Our outdoor cold plunge and sauna has an amazing view of the River Boyne and Mill wood. We prefer it to be used by responsible adults over the age of 18. Due to the nature of the heat generated we strongly advise children and pregnant ladies do not use the sauna. Please ensure swimming costumes are worn for the comfort of other guests and staff.

Swimming

We do not allow swimming in the nearby river as it is extremely fast and dangerous. Please do not attempt to swim here or you will be asked to leave immediately. If you have arranged a water-based activity with an outside supplier you are welcome to enter and / or exit the river on our grounds under their expert supervision.

Smoking

We ask guests kindly not to smoke in any of the indoor spaces. This includes all accommodation and enclosed public spaces. We remind guests that it is illegal, and a €500 fine will be applied if you or your guests are found to be in breach of this. We ask that guests kindly smoke outside and use the sand buckets provided.

Alcohol

No beverages of any kind will be permitted to be brought on to the premises by the client or any of the clients' guests or suppliers without special permission granted by the hotel. The property reserves the right to remove any such beverages and can ask this guest to leave. Please note your party gifts cannot be alcohol. Food and drink may not be consumed upstairs in the bedrooms. Residents are only allowed to consume alcohol in the resident's bar and reception rooms. The residents bar will remain open at the night manager's discretion. If alcohol is found upstairs, it will be removed, and guests will be asked to leave. Alcohol is not permitted in or beside the sauna for safety reasons.

Explore one of the most beautiful villages in Ireland and see where Saint Patrick burnt the snakes out of Ireland on the Hill of Slane

- Ledwidge Cottage, Francis Ledwidge Museum and War Memorial Centre - www.francisledwidge.com
- The museum is the cottage birthplace of World War I poet, Francis Ledwidge. It is a perfect example of a 19th century farm labourer's cottage
- Brú na Boinne Visitor Centre situated on the south bank of the river provides access and information on the world heritage sites; <http://www.worldheritageireland.ie/bru-na-boinne/> (9 minute drive)
 - Newgrange - a 5,200 year old passage tomb located in the Boyne Valley in Ireland's Ancient East.
 - Knowth - Two passages and is surrounded by seventeen satellite cairns.
 - Dowth - The only one of the three large Brú na Bóinne Passage Tombs which is not accessible from the Visitor Centre Visitors to Dowth must drive directly to the site on the north bank, a couple of miles from the Slane / Drogheda road. (12 minute drive)

 - The Battle of the Boyne was fought on the 1st of July 1690 and was a very important battle in Irish, British and European history.
- **Old Mellifont Abbey** - www.discoverboynevalley.ie/boyne-valley-drive/heritagesites/old-mellifont-abbey
 - The first Cistercian monastery in Ireland founded in 1142 by St Malachy of Armagh, its most unusual feature is the octagonal Lavabo c. 1200. The Visitor Centre houses an interesting exhibition on the work of masons in the Middle Ages with fine examples of their craft on display. Access to site by stone stairway.

 - High crosses & round tower founded in the late 5th century by Saint Buithe who died around 521.
- **Millmount Museum & Tower** - www.millmount.net.ie

 - Slane Castle Tours - historical tours throughout the Castle which will give you an opportunity to learn about the Conyngham Family, the history of the building and all about the concert's that have been held at the venue over the years.
 - Discover Slane Irish Whiskey - A tour of Slane Distillery takes visitors through their heritage room, barley room, cooperage, and maturation warehouse before a final stop that provides a view of the pot stills and production areas. The tour concludes in the best way possible with a taste of their signature triple casked blend, Slane Irish Whiskey.
 - St. Erc's Hermitage is to be found in the grounds of Slane castle, between the Church of Ireland church and the Boyne. It is now hidden in the thick undergrowth. While it is traditionally associated with St. Erc, what we see now dates to the 15th or 16th century. The building consists of a nave and a chancel with a tower in between.
